## Chaperone/Volunteer Training




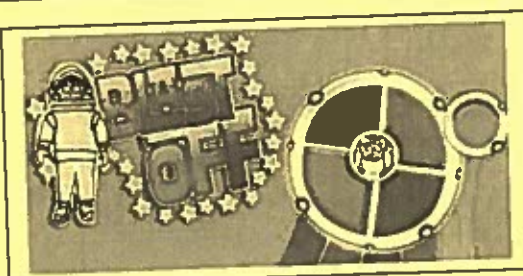
## Social Studies Fair Workshop

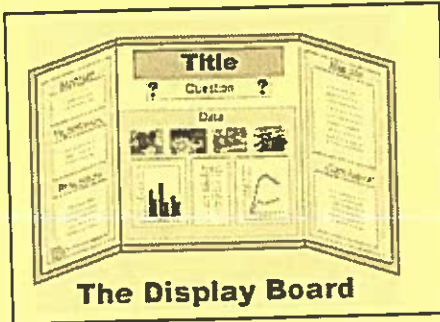

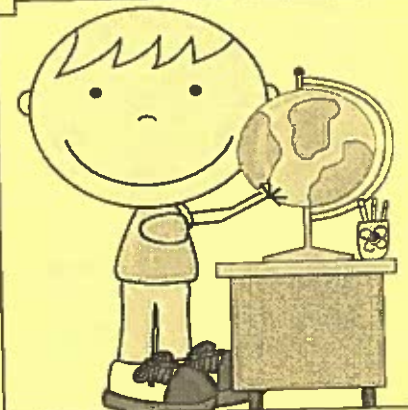
