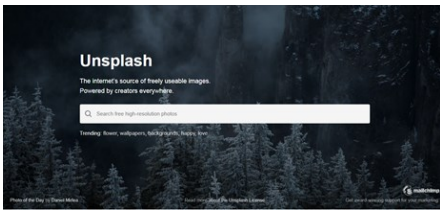
## Free Pictures Online

When using a Microsoft Office application (Word, Publisher, PowerPoint) you have the option to insert a picture from Bing. The results from the search within the application are all open source pictures that are not protected by copyright.

To insert a picture:

Click Insert -> Online Pictures -> type into Bing Image Search

A second option is [unsplash.com](https://unsplash.com) which has high quality photos that people have submitted to use without copyright protection.

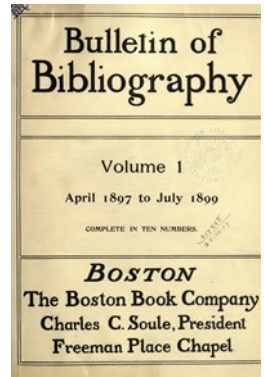
These are good sources to keep in mind when doing class projects!

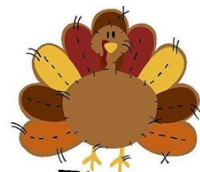


## Maybe your classroom needs:
