

School Calendar Highlights 2021-2022

The following details summarize the components of the proposed 2021-2022 calendar. Please refer to the attached calendar draft.

- The first day for employees would be August 12.
- Teachers will work in their schools on August 12 (Faculty Senate /Preparation Day) and August 13.
- Teachers will have two days of Continuing Education Days (August 16 and 17) at a site to be determined.
- The first day for students would be in school is August 18.
- The second Faculty Senate /Professional Learning Day will be on Columbus Day (October 11). Students will not be in attendance.
- Thanksgiving Break will be November 22-26 with no school for students or employees.
- The first semester would end on Wednesday, December 22 as a Faculty Senate/Professional Learning Day and students would not be in attendance. Employees will have the option of working off that day as we have in the past. (Open House, after school activities, family engagement activities, etc.) Faculty Senate is scheduled for that day and may be held outside of regular school hours during the month of December but prior to December 22. Professional employees will be required to document 4 hours in addition to the faculty senate hours and service employees must document 6 hours for trade-off time.
- Christmas Break will be December 23-January 2 with students returning to class on Monday, January 3.
- February 16 will serve as a Faculty Senate/Professional Learning Day in which students will not be in attendance.
- March 23 will be a Professional Development days for all employees. This day cannot be worked off in advance.
- Good Friday (April 15) will be a Faculty Senate/Professional Learning Day in which students do not attend. Employees may work off that day prior to Good Friday in the same fashion as December 22 including Faculty Senate meetings.
- Spring break will be April 18-22 with no school for students or employees unless school needs to be made up due to either a work stoppage or unforeseen catastrophic occurrence that cannot be predicted. It will be our intent to protect as many of those spring break days as possible.
- Graduation is scheduled for Sunday, May 22, 2022. (The law requires that we cannot schedule graduation more than 5 days prior to the end of school.)
- The last scheduled day for students would be May 25, 2022.
- The TP (Teacher Parent Conference Day) on June 8 can be worked off by all school employees if they attend 6 hours of Parent Teacher Conferences at their school.
- The last scheduled day for employees would be June 9.

Note: The six OS days (May 26-June 3) typically have been used to make up snow days. If we are permitted to use remote learning to occur on days that school is called off due to inclement weather, those days will not have to be used to make up snow days. Thus, the calendar would move 6 days forward creating a situation in which the TP day (for parent-teacher conferences) would become May 31 and the P (Closing day) would become June 1 which would be the last day for employees.
