CLASSIFICATION: School Bus Operator

QUALIFICATIONS: Applicant must possess a high school diploma or GED and must complete all state requirements for a bus operator, and execute job duties, as needed, assigned by the Transportation Director.

JOB DESCRIPTION: Morning Run: Pocahontas County High School to the Route 92/39 intersection at Minnehaha Springs and traveling Route 92 N to Frost. Travel Route 84 from Frost picking up students, return to Frost and meet transfer bus at Route 92 and Hill Country intersection. Travel Hill Country Road going through to Route 28 by Pocahontas County High School and on to Route 39 below Huntersville to Marlinton Middle School to transfer students, travel to Marlinton Elementary School and back to Pocahontas County High School, where the bus will be parked during the school day.

Evening Run: Reverse of morning run.

SNOW ROUTE: Morning Run: The bus will only travel Route 92, Hill Country Road, and Route 28. If Hill Country is impassable, then the bus will travel to Dunmore, turn left on Route 28 and travel to Pocahontas County High School, then proceed back to Route 28 onto to Marlinton Middle School to transfer students, travel to Marlinton Elementary School and back to Pocahontas County High School. May pick up students that other buses cannot.

Afternoon Run: Reverse of morning run.

SALARY: State Minimum Salary

TERM OF EMPLOYMENT: Effective April 22, 2021 for the remainder of the 2020-2021 school year. Term of employment is 33 days.
(NOTE: Term of employment shall be 200 days each year thereafter.)
